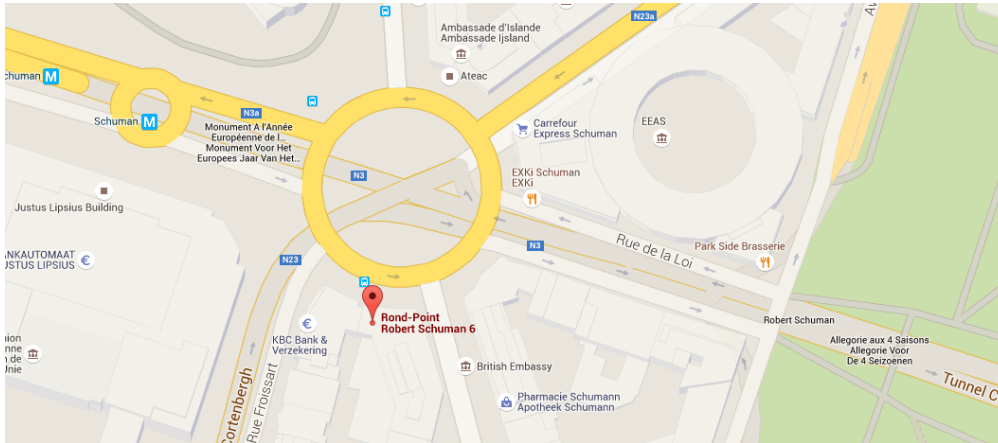


How to get to the ENAEE offices?

1. BY AIRCRAFT

From Brussels Airport:

By Train: There is a direct train connection from Brussels Zaventem Airport to Brussels-Schuman Train Station. Trains run every half hour and take some 20 minutes.

By Bus: The bus station is located at level 0 below the arrivals hall. It is accessible by escalators and elevators.

Two buses are available to reach Schuman square:

- Bus 12

- . operational from Monday to Friday (from 5:40am to 8pm)
- . duration: +/- 30 minutes
- . get off at Schuman station

- Bus 21

- . operational during the week (from 8pm to 12pm) and during the week-ends (from 5:40am to 12pm)
- . +/- 30 minutes
- . get off at Schuman station

2. BY TRAIN

- From South Station:

- Take the metro line 2 or 6 direction Simonis (Elisabeth),
- Get off at **Arts-Loi** station (6 stops)
- Take metro line 1 (direction Stockel) or line 5 (direction Hermann Debroux)
- Get off at **Schuman** station (2 stops).

Duration: +/- 17 minutes

- From Central Station:

- Take metro line 1 (direction Stockel) or line 5 (direction Hermann Debroux)
- Get off at **Schuman** station (4 stops).

Duration: +/- 9 minutes

- From North Station:

- Take the tram 3 (direction Churchill) or tram 4 (direction Stalle)
- Get off at **De Brouckère** station (2 stops)
- Take metro line 1 (direction Stockel) or line 5 (direction Hermann Debroux)
- Get off at **Schuman** station (5 stops).

Duration: +/- 17 minutes

3. BY CAR

- Highway from Liège (via E40)

- 93 kms
- +/- 1h10

- Take the tunnel direction centre when arriving in Brussels. You arrive directly in the EU area and you continue straight forward to the Schuman Square.

- Highway from Antwerp (via E19)

- 52 kms
- +/- 47 minutes

- Highway from Ghent (via E40)

- 59 kms
- +/- 1h
